Sterilization & Vaccination Program



Overview

It is the mission, duty and purpose of Murphy's Outreach, Resources & Education (M.O.R.E.) for Furry Friends to address, educate, support and provide financial aid, in an effort, to reduce companion animal neglect and surrendering to our local shelters.

M.O.R.E. for Furry Friends currently accepts applications from **York County Residents only** at this time. **Felines MUST be over the age of 6 months and at least 3lbs or under 8 years old for safety reasons. Senior and very young kittens are at a higher risk of complications during surgical procedures and require bloodwork prior to surgery.**

M.O.R.E. for Furry Friends encourages applicants to participate in their own support and we ask that all owners pick up and drop off their kitties to the pre-scheduled sterilization appointment. Applicants unwilling to assist in the process or exhibit irresponsible behaviors may be turned down for assistance. Applicant must show a willingness to take responsible care of their pet. We will deny any applicant seeking assistance for felines they intend to rehome, sell or use in illegal activities.

All applicants considered will have permanent feline residents of the home. At this time, we do not provide assistance to private organizations already conducting Trap-Neuter-Release programs.

Your kitty's spay or neuter will include a Rabies & Distemper Vaccine. We encourage you to follow up with a veterinarian to check your kitty's sutures & continue his/her next round of vaccinations to prevent deadly illnesses and infection.

If your kitty has had these vaccinations recently, you will need to provide proof at the drop-off so additional vaccinations will not be given.

It is **crucial** that you follow the pre-surgery instructions from Animal Rescue, Inc to the "T" to prevent complications during her surgery. We will send an email detailing the instructions for you and your kitty to the chosen applicants.

All applicants are required to either comment on the "Less is MORE" program posting when their kitty has been dropped off and picked up for surgery or email or message us directly so we know you have received the information and have not changed your mind. We have had applicants "disappear" without a word after they have been selected or emailed which takes a sterilization appointment away from another kitty that could have benefited from the program.
